6. Contract description and Objective of the service

Service Contract for the provision of a comparative juridical analysis on the issue of disability on Palestinian legislation.

The analysis should be focused on the implementation of the disability-related laws, in order to provide an integrated assessment of laws and policies on the subject of disability, supplying practical support to the law-making level and for citizens participation in the legislative process on the matter. Furthermore the study will contribute to the fruitful enhancement of the rights of people with disability in Palestine and it will become a reference instrument for the researchers involved in this field.









In particular, the analysis should identify gaps, deficiency and conflicts between the local legislation and international laws, taking into consideration the optimal laws and best practices implemented in the different countries. Among the current set of laws and regulations on the issue of disability and related topics, in which an urgent harmonization process is needed, the study must also specify how the relevant legislation should be modified accordingly. The study should report the expected results in which this process could lead to and all the necessary steps to be adopted in order to reach the expected results, including the related strategy. The study should refer also to the International Conventions on the rights of the people with disabilities such as the Convention of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (CRPD).

Finally, the study should also analyze the level of access to their rights by people with disability and it should suggest solutions for enhancing the level of access, identifying also best practices and best promising practices related to these issues.

The general objective of the analysis is to increase the planning and monitoring capacity on disability rights by central and district institutions; and to strengthen the collaboration network capacity to positively adapt the legislation on persons with disabilities.

The specific objective of the analysis is to provide practical support to the legislating authorities on the rights of the people with disability, identifying also the best practices related to this topic.

The main findings of the study will be used as a milestone for implementing a harmonization process related to the current set of laws and regulation on the issue of disability in Palestine.

7. Tender criteria

The tenderer will:

- Be an official Palestinian non-profit organization
- Have at least 3 years of experience in developing studies, publication and report related to the human rights and disability sector
- Have at least 3 years of experience in providing legal counselling and consultancy services related to juridical issues in the West Bank and Gaza Strip
- Have published reports and/or studies related to the situation of human rights and on disability issues in Palestine
