Service contract to development a specific Integrated Conservation and Risk Management Plan for the property as a whole that includes approaches to tourism and development regulations, in which it raised, assessed and identified different issues that need to be well managed to ensure the protection and enhancement of the sites, focusing on the Church of Nativity in Bethlehem.

9. Additional information

In recent years, substantial restoration works have been carried out at the Church of the Nativity, but certain issues are still missing, including the necessity of developing an Integrated Conservation and Risk Management Plan Integrated Conservation and Risk Management Plan.

Additionally, the relatively large numbers of tourists entering the Church on daily basis necessitates the revisiting and inspection of the mechanism set for their management inside the Church, whether in terms of their flow from the moment they get in until they leave, or in terms of their convenience and comfort.

To achieve this, AICS is looking for contracting a sectoral local NGO.

The involved team of work shall include the following key-expert:

- A senior WHSs Conservation and Management Risk international expert
- A junior architect and urban planner

In addition, the experts shall be supported by a local practitioner supporting with translation and in charge of coordinating the logistic during the mission.

The plan shall be prepared and submitted in max 180 working days.

The expert's team is expected to work closely with the PCRCN and MoTA and the three Christian denominations that oversee the Church of the Nativity (the Greek Orthodox Church, the Order of St. Francis, and the Armenian Church).
